August 2019 - Gourmet travel tip Berlin: eat! berlin fine dining guest performance // FOOD FOR THE EYES

Berlin, August 2019 - Germany's famous **culinary festival, eat! berlin**, meets the summer's most **popular photography exhibition**: On **August 13, 2019** one of the world's best fine dining festivals will serve up an **exquisite four-course menu with selected wine pairing** as part of the exhibition Food for the Eyes - The Story of Food in Photography.

The evening is hosted by festival director Bernhard Moser in the prominent **C/O Berlin gallery**, known also as America Haus. Responsible for savory and sweet delights are Best Chef of Europe **Sebastian Frank** (Madrid Fusion, 2018, Restaurant Horváth) and his Two-Star-Michelin colleague **Marco Müller** (Chef of the Year 2018, Rolling Pin Award, Restaurant Rutz). Young Michelin-Star chef **Max Strohe** (Rising Star of the Year 2016, Berliner Meisterköche, Speiselokal Tulus Lotrek) contributes an appetizing starter, **Karina Appeldorn** (Pâtissière of the Year 2015, Gault&Millau, Restaurant Hotel am Steinplatz) will complete the flavoursome four-course-meal with a modern dessert.

Surrounded by the works of **Nobuyoshi Araki, Peter Fischli, Irving Penn, Cindy Sherman** and other renowned photographers the guests can indulge eyes and taste buds in a cultivated ambience in the middle of Berlin. A 30-minute **guided tour** is included in this evening's experience, providing an insight into the many **stories of food in photography**.
